


Documents Evidencing Marriage Bona Fides

William Louis BAHN's Passport Taiwan Entry/Exit Stamps

My entry into Taiwan was done using my previous passport. When at the American Institute in Taiwan to have our marriage documents authenticated, I was told that I needed to replace my passport because of water damage to the cover. Therefore my exit from Taiwan was done using my new passport.
