## CSCI-410 Setting Up Your Directories (a.k.a. folders)

After unzipping your ECS Software Suite download you should have a directory structure on your computer that resembles the following:

```
..\nand2tetris\projects\00
..\nand2tetris\projects\01
..
..\nand2tetris\projects\nn
..
..\nand2tetris\projects\13</projects\13
```

Since several of the projects will be broken into two subprojects, it might be a good idea to get set up for that by making copies of those directories and naming them **nnA** and **nnB**.

It is recommended that you make a similar directory tree for the python assignments as follows:

```
..\python\PY01
..
..\python\PYnn
..
..\python\PY05
```

An alternative is to simply add the **PYnn** directories to the **nand2tetris\projects** directory.

Yet another alternative is to leave the **nand2tetris** directory untouched and do your work elsewhere. This allows you to easily retrieve or view the unmodified project files should the need arise. A simple way to do this is to copy the **projects** directory to another location. If you take this route, there is little reason not to then place the **PYnn** directories in this same place. This is the route I took and I simply called the top level directory **work**.
