Homework Submission Guidelines for CS-3020

You homework will normally consist of one or more C# apps. You will submit a single zip file for the entire homework via BlackBoard. The contents of the zip file should be contained in a top-level folder named "HWhh" where hh is the two-digit homework number (e.g., HW01 or HW12).

Within this folder should be separate folders for each solution. The name of the folder as well as the solution should follow the format "HWhh-p" where 'hh' is the two digit homework number and 'p' is the one digit program number within that homework (e.g., HW01-1).

As an example, the first homework assignment is problems 2.9, 3.28, and 4.14 from the Deitel & Deitel text. Thus the top level of folders should be

HW01 // Top-level folder → HW01-1 // Solution folder for Exercise 2.9 → HW01-2 // Solution folder for Exercise 2.28 → HW01-3 // Solution folder for Exercise 4.14

The project name should generally be the same as the solution name, but solutions are allowed to have multiple projects so this is not imperative. If the problem statement says to use a specific name for the project, then do so; otherwise use the solution name.

You may zip up your solution folders in their entirety, being sure to preserve folder hierarchy. If the total homework zip file exceed 1MB, then please delete the .exe files from the \Debug and \Release folders.

Unless otherwise indicated, please have your projects configured for Debug as this will help the grader try to find your errors. If you code has problems and you have it configured for Release, then the grader is not obligated to reconfigure it and will grade it based on how it behaves as submitted.
